OUR SPEAKER:

Lawrence M. Weiss, M.D., F.C.A.P is the medical director at Clariant. He received his B.S. summa cum laude and M.D. summa cum laude from the University of Maryland. He completed a residency in Anatomic Pathology at the Brigham & Women's Hospital in Boston, MA and a fellowship in surgical pathology at Stanford University Medical Center. He was previously an assistant professor at Stanford and director of surgical pathology, president of the medical staff, and chairman of pathology at the City of Hope.

Dr. Weiss's interests lie in tumor pathology, hematopathology, and immunohistochemistry. He is the author of over 500 papers and book chapters, as well as over a dozen books, including an AFIP lymph node fascicle. His laboratory discovered the first molecular evidence linking the Epstein-Barr virus with Hodgkin lymphoma. He has won numerous awards, including the Benjamin Castleman, Arthur Purdy Stout, and the United States-Canadian Academy of Pathology Young Investigator Awards, and has delivered over 250 national international talks in pathology, including several named lectureships. He is on the editorial board of ten scientific journals, and is a past President of the Los Angeles Society of Pathologists. He has been listed in the book *The Best Doctors in America* since 1994.
